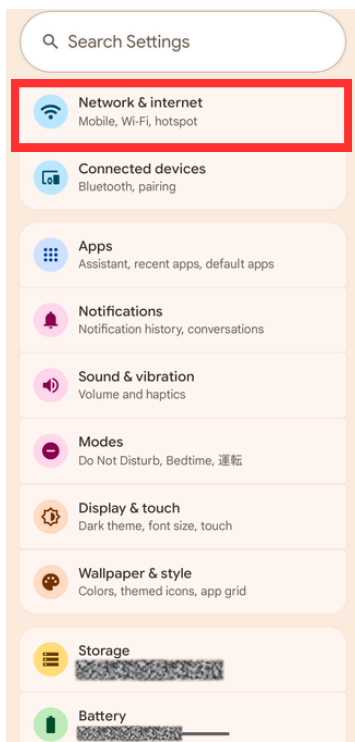


[For Android] eSIM Installation Guide – Step 1

We recommend performing this process while connected to a stable Wi-Fi network.

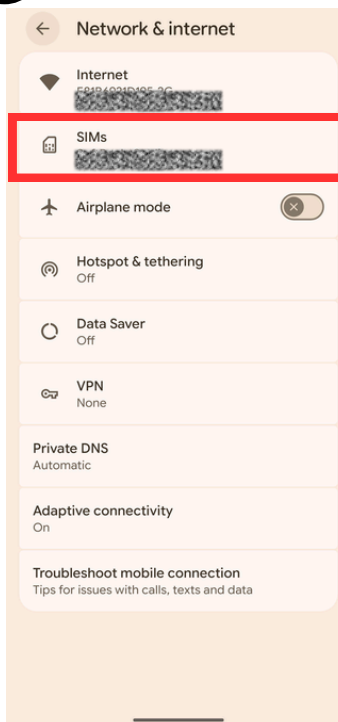

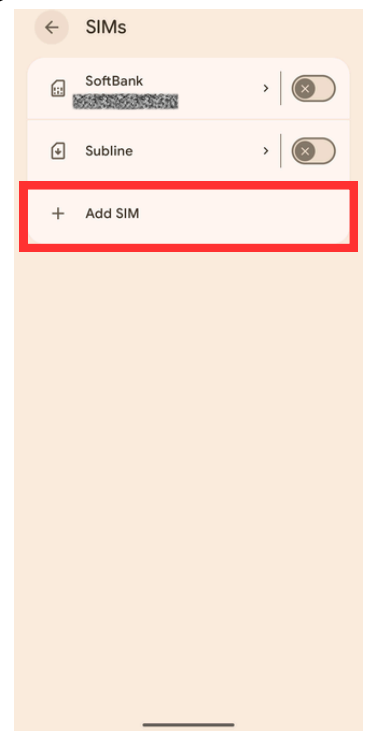
In the Settings app, go to Network & Internet → Mobile network and tap + Add carrier (or Add eSIM).

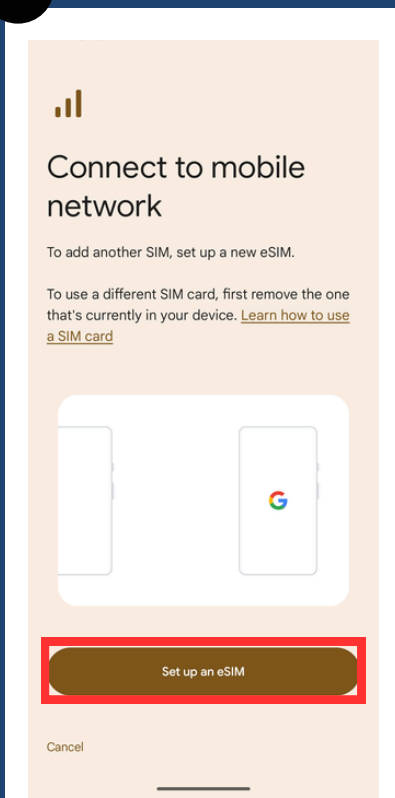
Tap SIM.

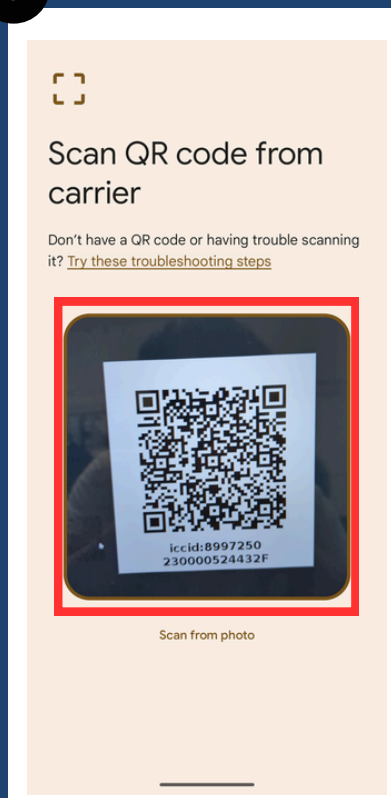
Tap Add SIM
(or Add carrier / Add eSIM)

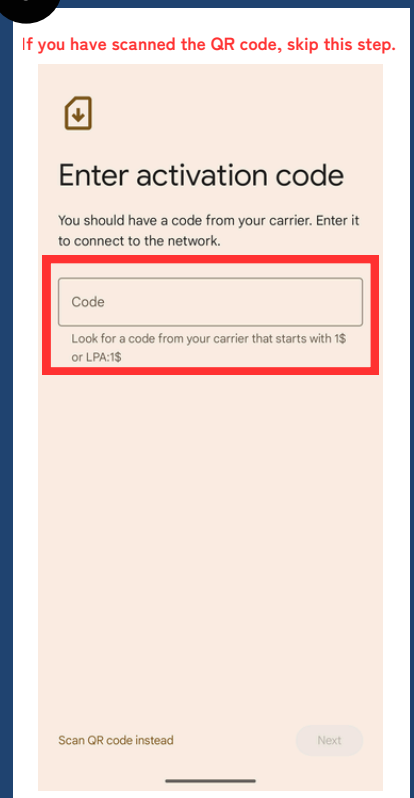
Tap Set up eSIM.

Scan the QR code.

If you are unable to scan the QR code, enter the Activation Code provided in your eSIM delivery email manually.

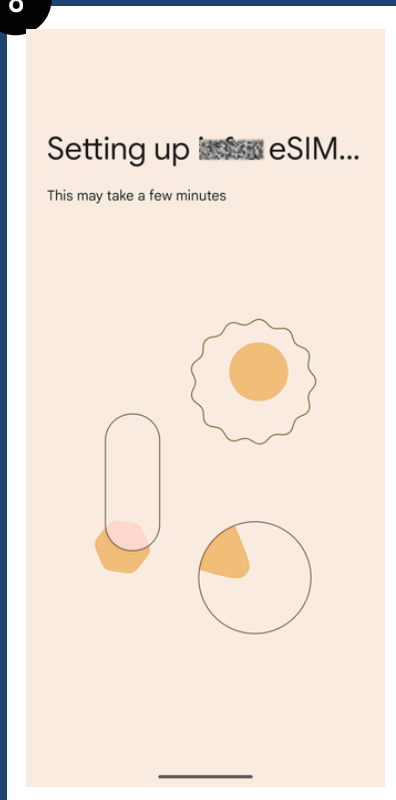

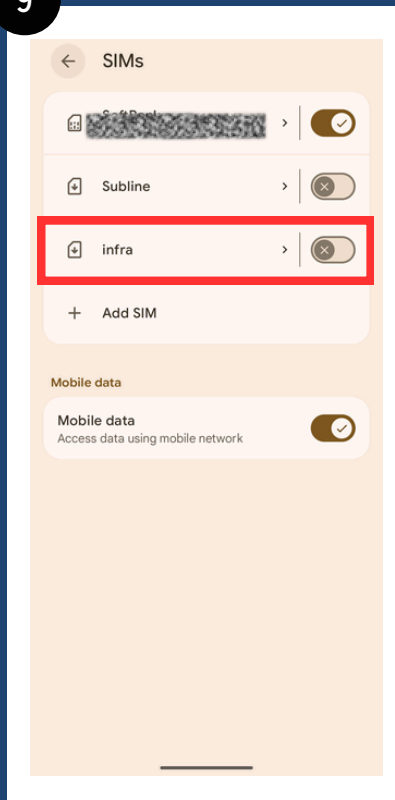
Once the screen changes, tap Settings.

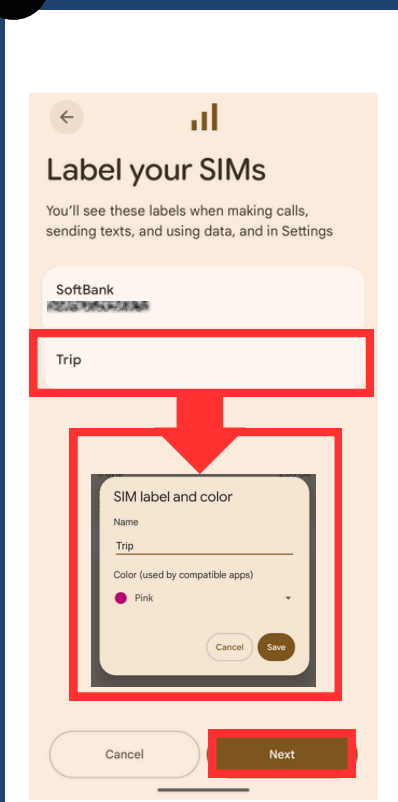

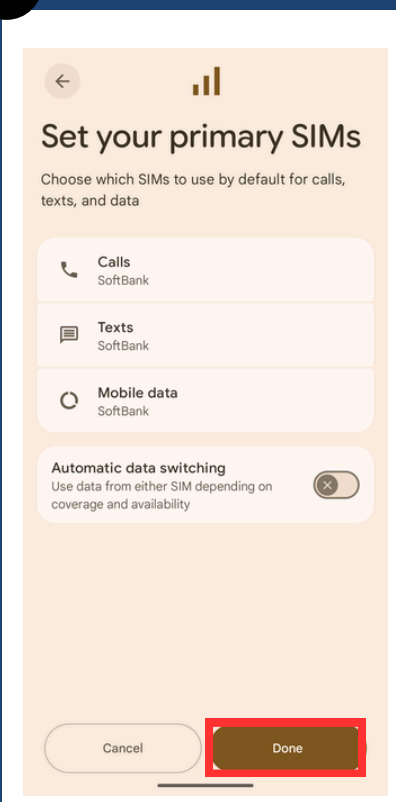
Once the installation is complete, the eSIM will be added. The eSIM name may vary depending on the package, such as "infra" "TGT" "Plus" "CMHK"
Note: Even if the eSIM is turned on, it will not be active until you connect to the internet locally.

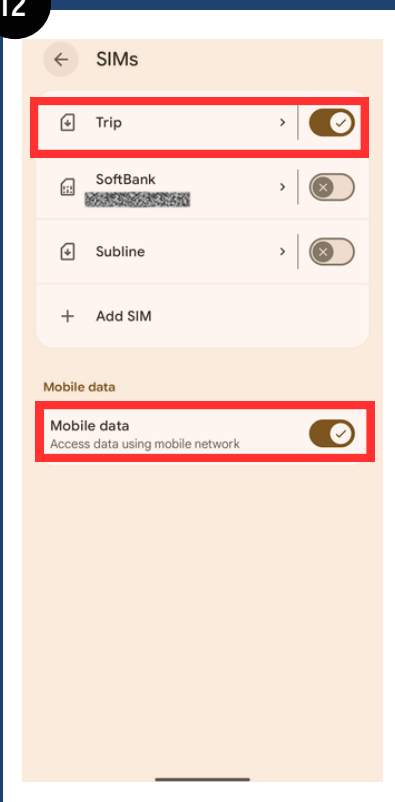
You can change the eSIM label to any name, such as "Trip."
Once you have set the name, tap Next.

If you do not want to switch to the eSIM before traveling, do not change your primary SIM. Simply tap Done to complete the installation process.

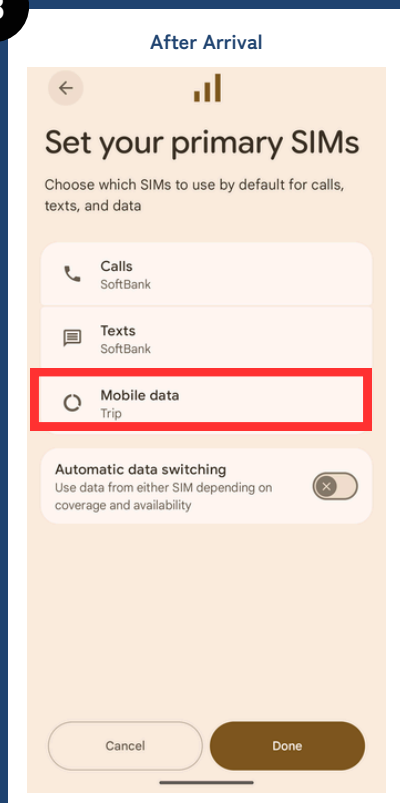
After arriving at your destination, switch Mobile Data to the newly installed eSIM.

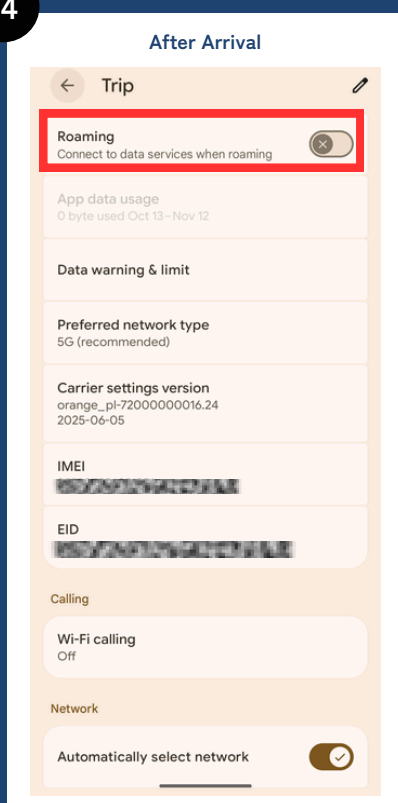

After arriving at your destination, switch Mobile Data to the newly installed eSIM.

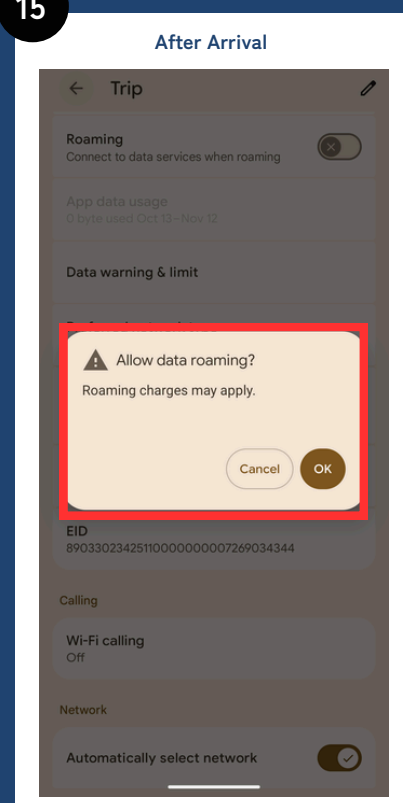
Note 1: Keep Automatic Data Switching turned off.
Note 2: You can keep the voice line on your primary SIM. If you do not plan to use international calls or SMS, you may turn it off or switch it to the eSIM.

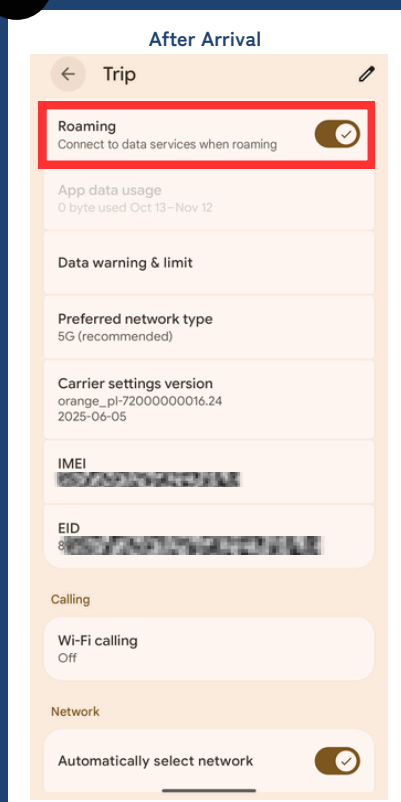
Roaming is currently turned off.
After arriving at your destination,
turn Roaming on.

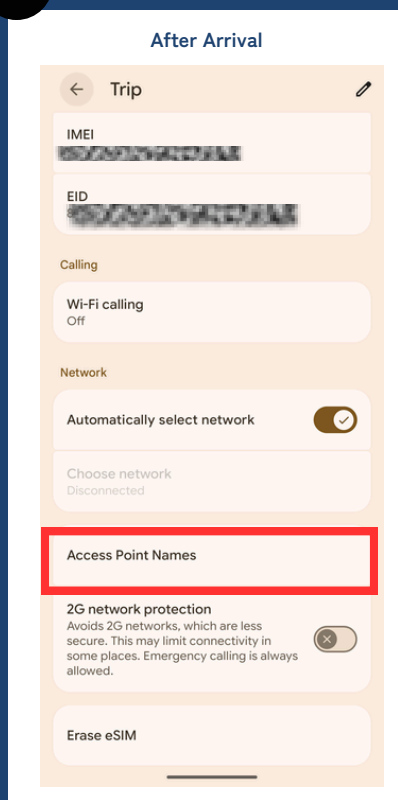
You may see a prompt asking, "Allow
Roaming?"
Tap OK to proceed.

Once roaming is enabled on the eSIM at your destination, it will start connecting to the internet.

If the internet does not connect, check the APN (Access Point Name) settings to ensure that the correct APN from your eSIM delivery email is selected.

18



If the APN is not selected, tap the radio button to choose it.
Once the correct APN is selected, the internet connection will start.
